Marzo 10 - Domingo - Day 1 Arrive in Paris



Private Transfer from Airport to Hotel

After collecting your luggage, head to the arrivals hall; your driver will hold a sign with your name on it.

Ideally located in the heart of Paris, on the Left Bank of the Seine, between the Montparnasse district and the Latin Quarter, the Hotel Lenox Montparnasse is the perfect place to discover the real Paris.

The 3* Boutique Hotel is housed in a beautiful building dating back to Baron Haussmann. Its warm and intimate ambience, where even the portraits of illustrious personalities seem to welcome you.



6 p.m. - Paris: Eiffel Tower Second Floor Access

2 Hours

Live a unique experience with local guides. Start your tour of the Eiffel Tower by meeting your guide, who will introduce you to the tower and the history of its construction. Ascend to the 2nd floor by elevator and take in the sweeping city views as you ascend this iconic landmark. At the end of the 2nd-floor visit, take the elevator that will take you to the top. At the top, enjoy some free time to take in views of the famous landmarks that can be seen atop the Eiffel Tower. See Notre Dame Cathedral, the Trocadéro Gardens, and the golden dome of the Hôtel des Invalides. On the way back down, be sure to stop at the 1st floor, where you can walk on the observation deck's glass floor and see an exhibition on the Eiffel Tower. Leave with your head filled with memories of the capital's enchanting views and a new perspective of this magnificent city.

Marzo 11 - Lunes - Day 2 Explore the Louvre



1 p.m. - Louvre Museum Skip-the-Line Tour With French Breakfast

Marzo 14 - Jueves - Day 5 Day Trip to Champagne Region



8 a.m. - Small Group Champagne Day Trip from Paris including Wine Tasting

8.5 Hours

Leave Paris behind and head off with your expert guide to the prestigious Moët and Chandon Champagne house in Epernay, the Champagne Capital. Easily boasting the most extensive Champagne cellars in the world, this luxury Champagne house is home to some 17 miles (28 km) of underground tunnels where their world-famous sparkling wine matures. As you tour this incredible labyrinth of chalk cellars with your guide, learn about the magical process of turning standard white wine into something fizzy! Hear about humidity levels and temperature control, and see how the bubbles get into each bottle. At the end of your 1.5-hour walking tour around the cellars, sample a glass of Moët Champagne and discuss its complex creation with fellow Champagne lovers in your group.

After lunch, hop back on board your air-conditioned minivan and leave Epernay for a ride around Reims Mountain Regional Nature Park, home to Grand Crus vineyards, before reaching Hautvillers with your guide. Known as 'the birthplace of Champagne,' this charming village is best known for its most famous ex-resident, Dom Pérignon, the innovative Benedictine monk who dedicated most of his life to producing and perfecting Champagne.

After enjoying the beauty of the vine and little villages and making a few stops en route, you will reach the last stop of your day, dedicated to visiting a family-run winery where you can taste four different champagnes before returning to Paris.

Marzo 15 - Viernes - Day 6 Explore Notre Dame





10:30 a.m. - Notre Dame quartier & Ile de la Cité Private 2-Hour Walking Tour in Paris

2 Hours

Follow in the footsteps of Marie Antoinette, Louis XIV, and Napoleon on this walking tour of Paris' historic center. Cross the Pont-Neuf bridge to Île de la Cité and discover the medieval heart of old Paris, passing iconic landmarks like the Cathedral of Notre Dame, Sainte-Chapelle, and the tower of St. Jacques. Along the way, hear stories of the Hundred Years' War and the two Napoleons from your guide, and enjoy views of the Seine River, the Pont des Arts bridge, and the Louvre.
