



San Carlos de Bariloche

San Carlos de Bariloche, is a city in the province of <u>Río Negro</u>, Argentina, situated in the foothills of the <u>Andes</u> on the southern shores of <u>Nahuel Huapi</u> <u>Lake</u>. It is located within the <u>Nahuel Huapi National Park</u>. After development of extensive public works and Alpine-styled architecture, the city emerged in the 1930s and 1940s as a major tourism centre with <u>skiing</u>, <u>trekking</u> and <u>mountaineering</u> facilities. In addition, it has numerous restaurants, cafés, and chocolate shops. The city has a permanent population of 108,205 according to the 2010 census.

The name Bariloche comes from the <u>Mapudungun</u> word Vuriloche meaning "people from behind the mountain" (vuri = behind, che = people). The <u>Poya people</u> used the Vuriloche pass to cross the Andes, keeping it secret from the Spanish priests for a long time.

Nahuel Huapi lake was known to Spaniards since the times of the <u>Conquest of Chile</u>. Following the trails of the <u>Mapuche</u> people across the Andes, in the summer of 1552–1553, the Spanish Governor of the Captaincy of Chile <u>Pedro de Valdivia</u> sent <u>Francisco de Villagra</u> to explore the area east of the Andes at the latitudes of the city of <u>Valdivia</u>. Francisco de Villagra crossed the Andes through



Mamuil Malal Pass and headed south until reaching <u>Limay River</u> in the vicinity of Nahuel Huapi Lake.





Bariloche: Trek to the Castaño Overa Glacier Lookout

HIke up 10 km to enjoy stunning views of the Castaño Overa and Ventisquero Glaciers while exploring the natual landscapes of the Tronador Volcano.


